Keynote Speaker—David Crane

Gonzaga University School of Law, in conjunction with the Gonzaga Journal of International Law and the International Law Society, proudly present this Fall's International Law Symposium, "crime without borders." This year's symposium undertakes the turbulent world of international crime. We will take an in-depth look at crimes against international law and transnational organized crime.

Our conversation this year will be facilitated by Keynote Speaker, Professor David Crane. Professor Crane teaches international criminal law and national security law at Syracuse University College of Law. Professor Crane is also the former Chief Prosecutor of the Special Court for Sierra Leone.

His appointment to that position by UN Secretary General Kofi Annan on April 19, 2002, marked the first time since the Nuremberg trials that an American has served in that capacity. Dr. Crane also served as the former director of the Office of Intelligence Review and as Assistant Counsel to the Defense Intelligence Agency.

Joining David Crane is US Prosecutor George Jacobs III. Mr. Jacobs has prosecuted various transnational organized crime cases, including the diploma mill and Nigerian e-mail scams.

Our co-facilitators this year are Criminal Law Attorney Mark Vovos and Gonzaga Law School Professor Dr. Upendra Acharya PHD.
